1. Your group is presenting tomorrow. One member did nothing, but now asks to put their name on the project.

What is the most Dharmic response?

Best Dharma Choice: C

Best Dharma Choice: C

Why? Dharma is calm courage. You can be honest without being hurtful, and your friend can improve with gentle guidance.

Takeaway: Truth can be shared with kindness — that is true courage.

4. Someone posts an unkind comment about a classmate in a group chat.

What should you do?

- A. Join in so you're not left out
- B. Ignore it completely

Best Dharma Choice: B

Why? Dharma is slow but steady and strong. Standing up for what is right may take courage, but it always protects what is good.

Takeaway: Even small acts of courage can make a big difference.

5. You are scolded by a parent for something you did not do.

What is the Dharmic response?

- B. Stay calm and explain respectfully later

Best Dharma Choice: C
